*IT Specialist*

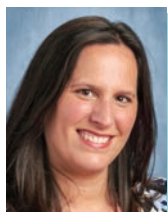

## Letter from Charles Rudnick, Director of Advancement

Dear Members of the DCD Community,



The 2021-2022 school year was marked by, among other significant accomplishments, a record-breaking year of philanthropy for DCD.

Thanks to your generosity, DCD's Annual Fund reached its highest level ever, raising nearly \$680,000

to support the school's operating budget. The critical programs supported by the Annual Fund include financial assistance, teacher salaries, and campus upkeep, and ensure that our teachers and staff have the tools, training, and technology they need to bring our mission to life for our students every day. These resources have been especially impactful in the current economic climate of rising costs.


Our Together capital campaign, which remains in its "quiet phase," received the largest gift in DCD's history – \$3 million, from a past parent and past trustee – keeping us on track toward the campaign's exciting goals of rebuilding our key gathering spaces, such as the Lowell Center and Lawrence lunch

room, and strengthening our endowment. Another generous campaign gift, from a grandparent, allowed us to start construction on our new science and multipurpose room, expected to be completed in the spring of 2023. More details about the campaign will be forthcoming in the months ahead.

In addition to these notable milestones, the pages of this report demonstrate a truly inspirational level of support for the school not only from current parents, but from alumni, grandparents, past parents, friends, and faculty (who reached 100% participation in the Annual Fund for the 12th year in a row!) Our 8th grade families came together and significantly enhanced the outdoor learning and gathering spaces behind the Valentine Center, which have become even more essential since the pandemic, as their generous 8th Grade Parent Gift.

We appreciate that behind each name on this report is a story, and we are truly grateful that each one of you has made DCD part of your story.

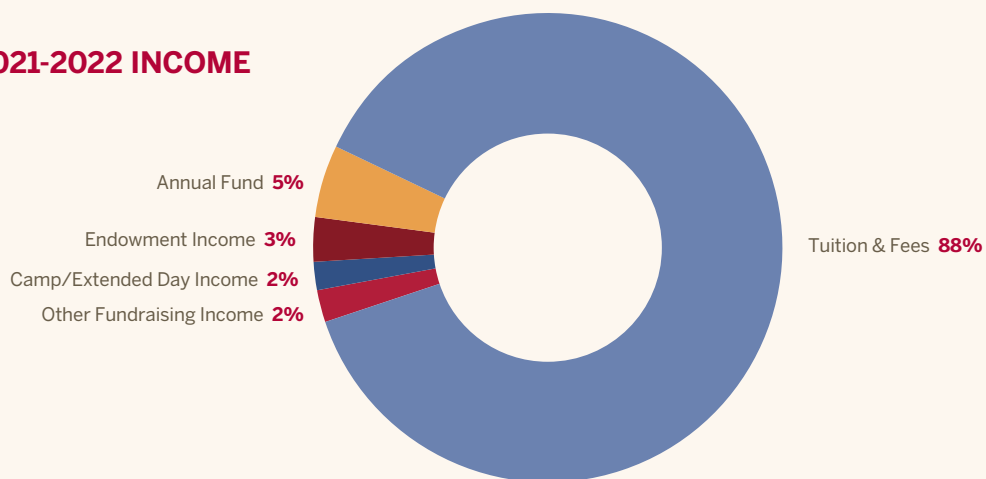

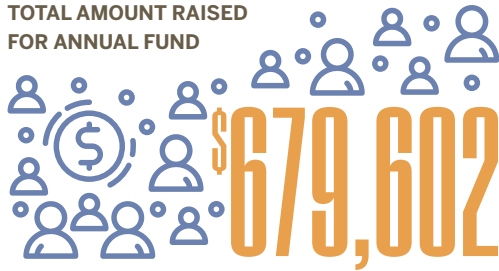

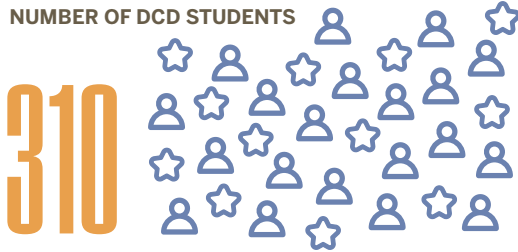

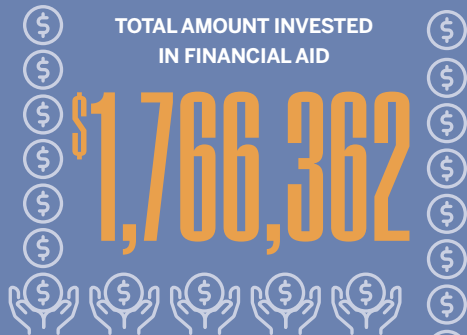
TOTAL AMOUNT RAISED

## Class of 2022 8th Grade Parent Gift Enhances Outdoor Gathering Spaces

Thanks to the generosity of the parents of DCD's 2022 8th Graders, the school has been able to enhance access to, and usability of, the outdoor learning and gathering spaces behind the Middle School.
